- ECE to spend \$14 million across the Territories to replace Jordan's Principle funding changes
- No time frame as to when to expect funding
- Sir John went from 14 Educational Assistants last year to 7 this year
- Some Jordan's Principle money was awarded over a 2 year time span so if a student came from another school in YK1 and still had funding it was transferred to Sir John with the student
- Exams and accommodations for students during exams will look different with staffing changes
