

Real World Experience

Range Lake North (RLN) is an inclusive school, where staff work to ensure that all students feel welcome and supported. Students work at various levels and follow a range of programs. To meet diverse needs, talents, and strengths, RLN uses research-based best-practices and differentiated instruction.

Learners participate in a wide variety of extra-curricular activities and clubs that promote collaboration and connection across grade levels.

Equipped with a virtual desktop and robotics lab, lego robotics lab, classroom chromebooks, print kit, Smart Boards and document cameras, RLN provides students with a world of opportunity. These tools allow students to engage with technology in hands-on, meaningful ways. Through these experiences, learners build creativity, confidence, and lifelong skills that benefit them both in and beyond the classroom.

Quality Education

RLN has a strong academic focus in areas of literacy and numeracy. Students engage with a balanced literacy approach to develop their reading, writing and oral language skills. Teachers use inquiry-based learning to help students explore and understand the world around them.

Mathematical concepts are taught through real world connections using a student-centered, problem-solving approach. Students build upon their understandings and learn new strategies so that mathematical concepts become more meaningful to them.
