

ESJFHS Dress Code

Our dress code recognizes that all students have the right to express themselves fully in school through their choice of clothing, hair styles, jewelry, and accessories. We ask that students adhere to the following:

- Hats, bandanas and other hat-like headgear are not permitted in the school.
- Clothing depicting violence, profanity, discriminatory, hateful, or pornographic images or sentiments, or drug, tobacco and alcohol use is unacceptable and should not be worn in school or at school events.
- Suitable footwear must be worn at all times in the school. Special protective clothing, as required for some shops and labs, must be worn when necessary.
- Students are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to the environment of a school. While there are particular guidelines that are useful in determining what is appropriate for students to wear to school, these are not hard and fast rules, as they are almost impossible to consistently enforce. Such considerations include: clothing that reveals a student's undergarments or pants hanging too low to see undergarments, shirts and skirts that are see-through, etc.

In the event that a student is wearing something that a staff member believes is not appropriate for the school environment, the staff member will address the issue with the student and ask them to change their clothing or not to wear that item at school in the future, or they may also contact the school administration team for guidance.
