

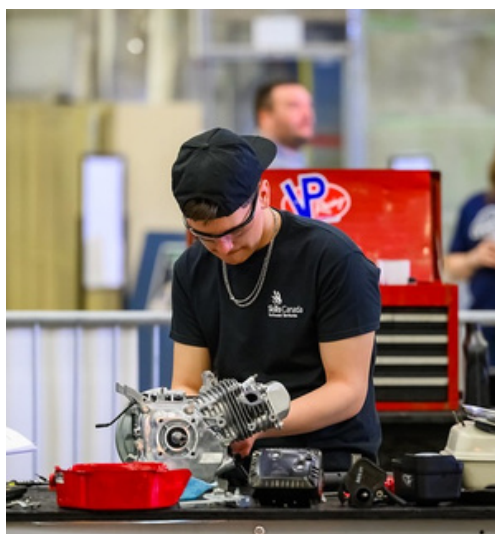

Thank you to our guests for sharing their knowledge, traditions, and time with our students. It was great to see everyone engaged, learning, and having fun together. Mahsi cho.



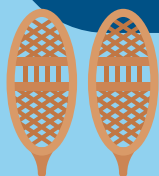

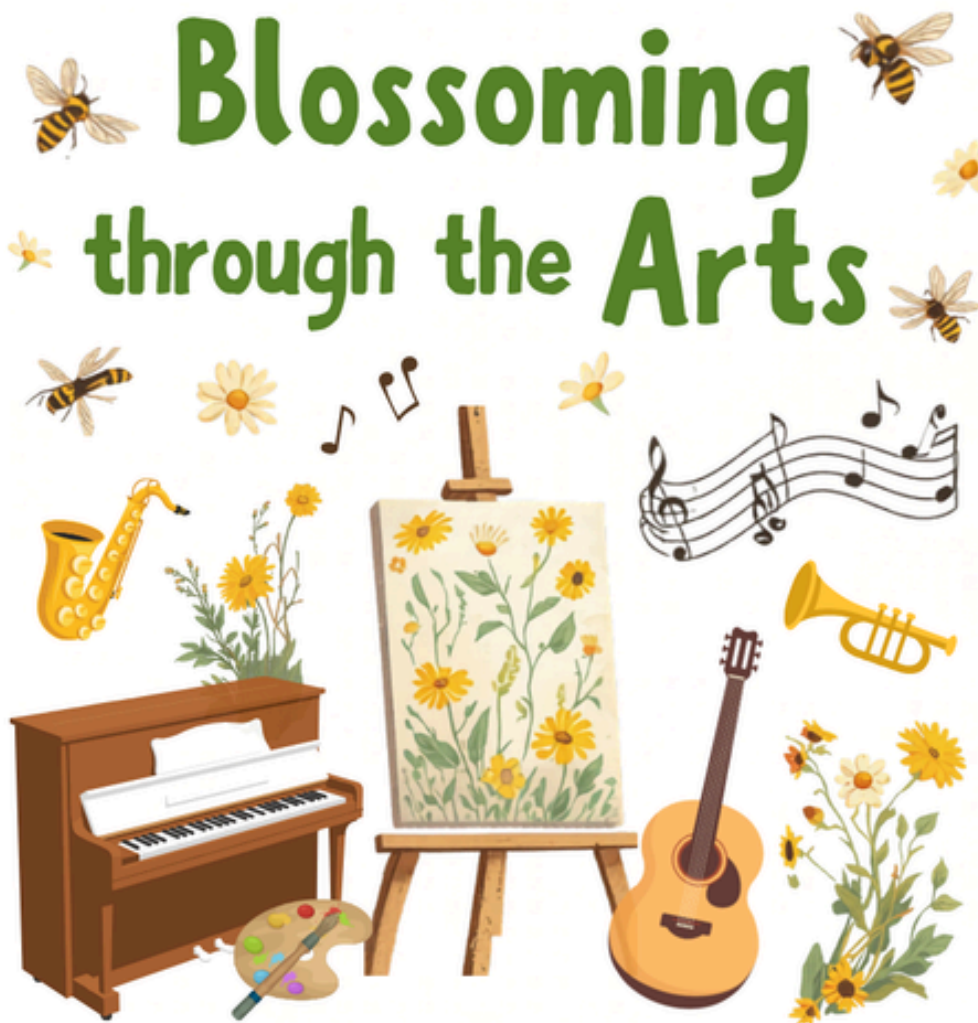

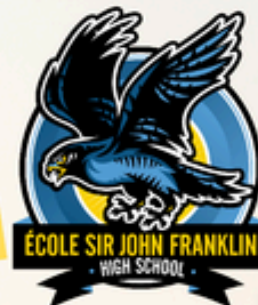

NWT Minimum Graduation Requirements

The NWT will be moving from a 5-credit to 4-credit system; this simply means that the credit values for courses will change and does not reflect reduced academic expectations of students.

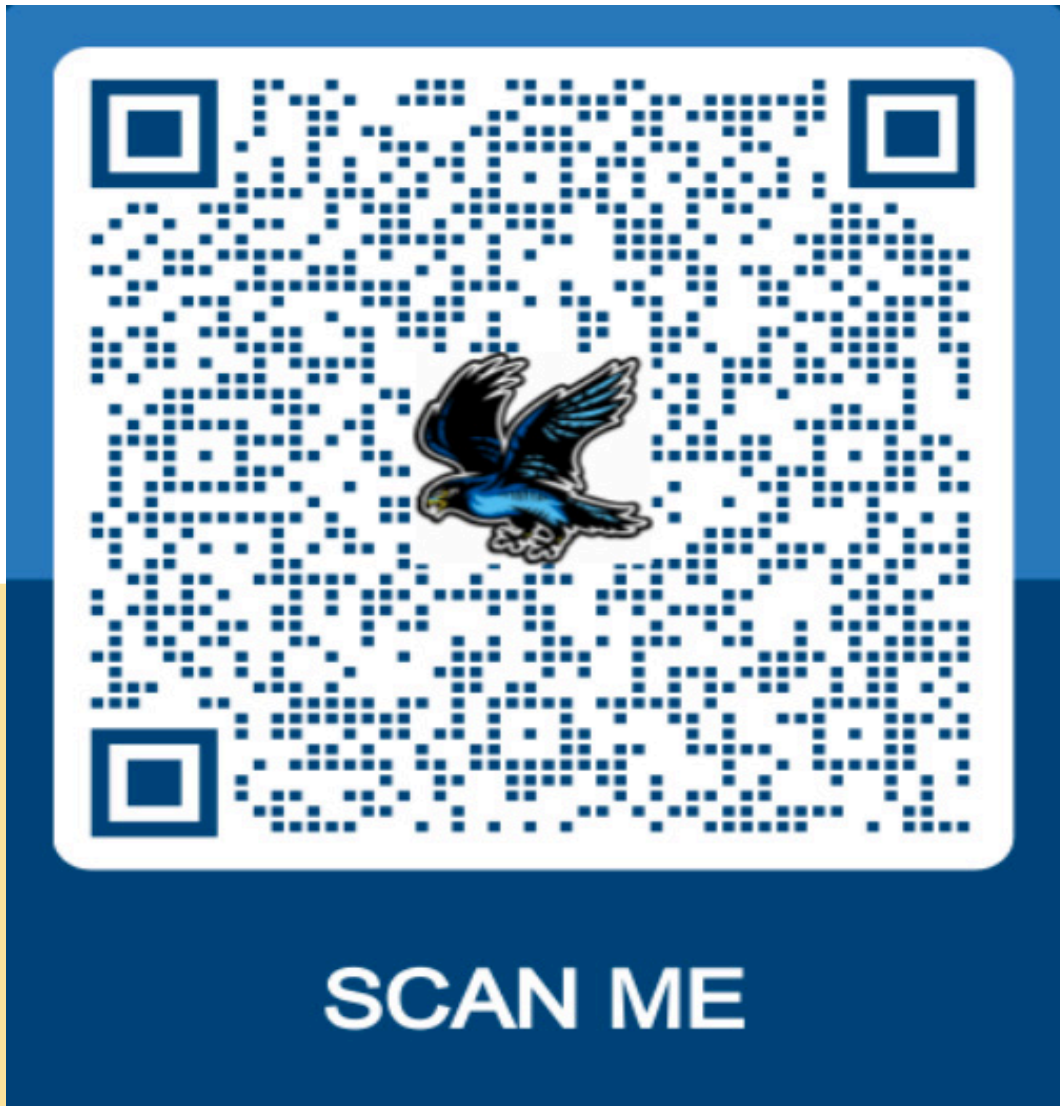
