Junior Kindergarten to Grade 5

French Immersion language program includes a strong focus on literacy, math, and culturebased education. Every classroom is equipped with a SmartBoard that promotes the integration of technology across the curriculum. Students in Grades 2 to 5 also learn to use mobile chromebooks. These technologies provide students with exciting opportunities to develop a skills-set which has lifelong benefits.

Music, physical education, and outdoor programs, are taught in French, adding to the overall learning experiences available to students.
