#### Current grade 9's:

#### Current grade 10 & 11 students:

Instructions for Selecting Courses:

- 1. Log in to the PowerSchool website using your student account: <a href="https://yk1.ece.gov.nt.ca/public">https://yk1.ece.gov.nt.ca/public</a>
- 2. Select Class Registration on the left hand side
- 3. On each subject, shttps://yk1.ece.gov.nt.ca/publicelect your required courses
- 4. Hit submit
- 5. If you have completed each section and have selected enough credits, a list will be created with all your selections.
- 6. You can then log out

#### Grade 12 students wanting to return:

You can follow the steps noted above for grade 10 & 11 students. If PowerSchool does not allow you to make the selections, please contact your academic counselor.

#### Notes:

Please refer to the <u>Course Selection Handbook</u> for more information on the courses offered at Sir John.

If you can not select a course you want/need (ie/ you need both ELA 20-1 and ELA 30-1) or if you would like to select a CTS twice, please email your academic counselor to help you.

# MAGMA Coffeehouse




On Wednesday February 15th MAGMA hosted its first coffeehouse of the year. Many students came to sing, read poetry and more. We hope to host more of these in the future.

We would like to thank everyone who donated to this event. Some special mentions:




