

YK1 & YCS School Boards Trustee's Election

October 18, 2021

Eligibility

You are eligible to vote if you:

- Are a Canadian citizen,
- Have attained 18 years of age, and
- Have resided in Yellowknife for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding Election Day

Residence

Your residence is the place that you adopt as your home and to which you intend to return to when you are absent. For the purpose of election, you may only have one residence.

Are You on the Voter's List & School District Enumeration?

If you have changed residence or are new to Yellowknife since October 2018 please click this link:

Please include for each eligible person that is registering to vote:

- Complete name (first, middle name, family name)
- Address (Number, Street, City, Postal Code)
- Phone number & Email
- Date of Birth
- School Board Support – choose only one for each eligible voter
 - a) Public (Yellowknife Education District No 1) b) Separate (Yellowknife Catholic Schools)

Where a resident supports both school boards, the Education Act states that the resident may vote for either Board but may not vote for both. Determination of your school district of choice is based on the enumeration process and not the Tax Roll. When support is not indicated, the voter record will default to 'Public'. Your support needs to be selected on your enumeration form and not at the Poll.

Students

Students living temporarily outside of Yellowknife and who meet all the eligibility requirements are still eligible voters.
